

## Appeal Notification for Tump Lane

**I have received a notification of appeal, against planning refusal, this morning as follows:**

**Site:** Land at Tump Lane, Much Birch, Herefordshire

**Description:** Proposed erection of 12 affordable dwellings, comprising a mixture of 2 and 3 bed houses on land off Tump Lane

**Appeal No:** P131680/F

An appeal has been made to the Secretary of State by Markey Builders (Gloucester) Ltd against Refusal of Planning Permission. The appeal was lodged on 18th August 2014. and is to be decided on the basis of Written Representations and a site visit by an Inspector.
