

Petition calling for more speed restrictions in village

A petition for more speeding restrictions in a village lane was handed in to the county council.

Eric Joseph gave a petition of 335 signatures to chairman of Herefordshire Council Brian Wilcox calling for chicanes to put in place in Tump Lane in Wormelow and a reduction of the 40mph speed limit.

He collected signatures in the village after his wife, Doreen, was knocked down in a hit and run in Tump Lane in August by a stolen Land Rover. She was taken to hospital and sustained bruising.

Mr Joseph said he wanted to keep the momentum going.

Cllr Wilcox said he will give the petition to cabinet member for transport and roads, Paul Rone, who will then send a response to Mr Joseph.
