Officers will continue to come to people when they need them and provide a high quality service however you contact us - in person (on the street, at community bases and at partners and communities together [PACT] meetings), on the phone or online.

General Policing Rural

In **October** there were **153** incidents reported to the police for the South Hereford Rural Area which were either, attended and dealt with by us, or response officers. **21** of these were "Grade 1", which means 999 emergency calls which is either life threatening or a crime in progress. There were **26** crimes. These are broken down in to; **8** Theft, **4** Assault, **7** Misc, **4** Damage and **3** Burglary.

Items of note

Op Protect ran from 28th October to 6th November. Op Protect should have given you an insight into what we get upto on a daily basis, if you follow us on twitter. Here is a run down of what we got upto.

31/10/16 PS Freer and PCSO Anderson delivered no trick or treat signs and no flour and egg signs to local shops in south Hereford town.

01/11/16 PC Phillips and PCSO Anderson conducted area patrols of known hot spots for ASB in Kingstone.

01/11/16 PS Freer and PCSO Anderson conducted licensing checks at three stores along Belmont road who are known to be selling alcohol early in the mornings to street drinkers who cause ASB in the local area.

03/11/16 PCSO Anderson and PC Helyer, distributed "The police will keep you safe" leaflets to local schools, Riverside, St Martins, Marlbrook, Little Dewchurch, Much Birch and St Weonards. 600 leaflets have been distributed.

04/11/16 PC Phillips and PCSO Anderson carried out Mobile phone enforcement along Belmont Road.

04/11/16 PCSO Westlake and PC Helyer visited vulnerable members of our community who have been suffering from domestic violence.

PC Roger Bradley has said his good byes to South Wye and is now policing the Golden Valley SNT area out of Peterchurch station. Roger has been at South Wye since August 2011 and I am sure you are with us in wishing him well. Worry not though, we have a new PC, PC Kirsty OBrien.

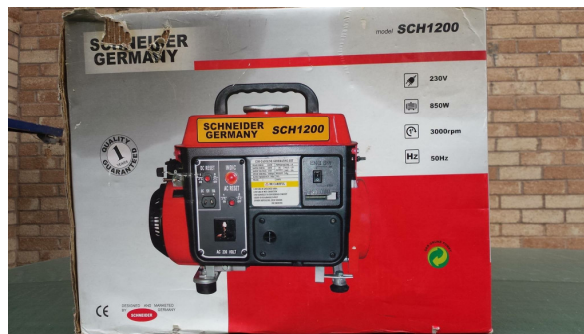
Kingstone
