### **General Policing Rural**

In **September** there were **133** incidents reported to the police for the South Hereford Rural Area which were either, attended and dealt with by us, or response officers. **18** of these were "Grade 1", which means 999 emergency calls which is either life threatening or a crime in progress.

There were **20** crimes. These are broken down in to; **4** Theft, **5** Assault, **4** Misc, **3** Damage and **4** Burglary.

#### Items of note

Wormelow - 413s 260916 – On 26<sup>th</sup> September it was noticed a boundary fence has been cut big enough for a vehicle to pass through to gain assess to land. Nothing has been stolen.

Kingstone – 823s 220916 – At 22:15 on 22<sup>nd</sup> September two windows were smashed on a residential property. The resident was in at the time and saw three figures running away from the property.

MuchBirch – 169s 220916 – Between 21:00 21<sup>st</sup> September and 09:00 22<sup>nd</sup> September a garage has been broken into. A KTM Motorbike and a push bike were stolen.

Kilpeck – 303s 200916 - Between 17:00 on the 19<sup>th</sup> September and 08:30 on the 20<sup>th</sup> September barns have been broken into. Tools and Copper have been taken.

Pontrilas – 156s 200916 – Before 16:30 on the 19<sup>th</sup> September and 07:30 on the 20<sup>th</sup> September a power substation has been broken into. 22 rolls of copper were stolen.

MuchDewchurch – 228s 070916 – Between 18:00 on the 5<sup>th</sup> September and 09:00 on the 7<sup>th</sup> September a storage box was broken into. A chainsaw, a toolbox and two winches were stolen.

Kilpeck – 437s 041016 – Between 23:00 3<sup>rd</sup> October and 04:00 4<sup>th</sup> October a guad bike was stolen from farm land.

Didley – 90s 031016 – Between 17:00 on 2<sup>nd</sup> October and 07:30 3<sup>rd</sup> October a red smallholder agricultural tractor 1650cc was stolen from a garage.

Please be aware that any information provided within this letter is to inform you of incidents of note and to request possible assistance. We do not want to worry you in anyway. Any incidents stated are infrequent and spread about a wide area. Herefordshire is a safe place to live!


