Kingstone Arrests

Monday (25th March) and Tuesday (26th March) saw Southside & Rural SNT conduct a pre-planned operation to target rural crimes committed in Kingstone and surrounding villages. Officers swapped shifts to work into the night with other Safer Neighbourhood Teams and policing teams. 4 arrests were made for Burglary and Theft offences and the investigation is still ongoing.

Two stolen quadbikes were also recovered by officers due to be returned to their rightful owner.
