



History of the Hotel Name

The Hotel takes its name from its position on the Pilgrimage route for St Ethelbert, who was King of East Anglia from circa 779 to his untimely death in 794.

Ethelbert was lured to the Palace of King Offa, just north of Hereford, where he was promised the hand of the King's daughter, Eadburgh, in marriage.

When he arrived at Sutton Walls Palace he was treacherously captured & beheaded with his body thrown into a ditch.

He was eventually reunited with his head by a local monk and laid to rest in a tomb on the site of the current Hereford Cathedral. Miracles were later reported to be connected to his shrine and he was later Canonised.

"Saint Ethelbert" is now one of two patron saints of the Cathedral, which has created the Order of St Ethelbert in his honour

PARISH MEETING - at the Parish Council Meeting held on the 5th March 2020 at the Much Birch Community Hall.

The Parish Council heard about concerns regarding parking on the yellow lines outside the Much Birch School, and the adjacent nursery. Please could everyone think carefully when dropping off or picking up from the area of the School and try not to put yourself, or others, at risk and keep the yellow lined area clear?

The Parish Council also heard about concerns regarding local flooding and drainage issues. There was a discussion about the responsibility for maintaining ditches and drainage adjacent to a water course and this lies with the riparian landowner.

There was a planning application considered at the meeting, the Parish Council considered comments from the floor and a response to the application was sent in to the Planning Department at Herefordshire Council.
