NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

Little Birch & Aconbury Neighbourhood Plan

Referendum on the adoption of the Little Birch & Aconbury Neighbourhood Plan

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday, 30th May 2019** to decide on the question below:

'Do you want Herefordshire Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Little Birch & Aconbury to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'
2. Applications to be included on the register of electors for this referendum must be received no later than **Monday, 13th May 2019**.
3. New applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations for existing proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Town Hall, St Owen Street, Hereford, HR1 2PJ by 5pm on **Tuesday, 14th May 2019**.
4. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Town Hall, St Owen Street, Hereford, HR1 2PJ by 5pm on **Tuesday, 21st May 2019**.
5. Applications to vote by proxy at this referendum applied for on grounds of physical incapacity, where that physical incapacity occurred after 5pm on **Tuesday, 21st May 2019** must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Town Hall, St Owen Street, Hereford, HR1 2PJ by 5pm on **Thursday, 30th May 2019**.

Duchy Walk

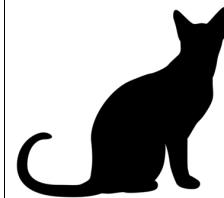

Little Birch & Aconbury Joint Neighbourhood Development Plan Referendum

Following a successful Public Examination, Herefordshire Council has put the **Little Birch & Aconbury Joint Neighbourhood Development Plan to Referendum**. This is the final key stage in the process and will be undertaken in a similar way to those for local elections.

The Referendum will ask: ***'Do you want Herefordshire Council to use the Neighbourhood Development Plan for Little Birch and Aconbury to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'***

The Ballot Paper asks you to mark a cross (X) in the box next to your choice – **Yes or No**.

Just to remind residents of the two parishes in September 2016 a Residents' Questionnaire was returned by well over 75%. It was that questionnaire that was the basis of the Development Plan. This was produced by the Steering Group made up by residents of the two parishes - with the considerable help from our consultant, David Nicholson – a planning expert.

All residents of Little Birch and Aconbury on Herefordshire Council's electoral register now have the opportunity to show their support for the Plan. I urge you please, to use your vote on **Thursday 30 May** - and with a **YES vote** we can help protect our communities and environment that are so important.

For the Plan to proceed, more than 50% of those voting need to cast their vote in favour. It will then be adopted by Herefordshire Council and become part of the **Statutory Development Plan** and be used to determine planning applications for both parishes.

The Writing Group thought the readers of the Newsletter might like to know a little of what goes on in Little Birch Village Hall. This month features the Gardening Club – the most popular group. It has been running since 1958 when founded by D. Enoch, J. Bryant, C. Farmer and W. Rowan and has never looked back.

It has a large membership from several villages in the area and meets once a month, usually on the last Wednesday.

Other than the social gathering accompanied by refreshments (non alcoholic!) there are various activities, often a speaker – paid for by members' subscriptions. When spare plants are available, 'Bring and Buy' sales provide a good way to use up surplus stock or buy something different.

In the Summer months various outings to interesting gardens or nurseries are arranged, members using their own transport or sharing cars.

Occasionally members open their own gardens for the Club. This is a good excuse to have a good tidy up!

At Christmas time a party is held for members and their partners/guests. The menu is traditionally Shepherd's Pie, followed by Apple Pie made by members of the Club. There is usually some form of light entertainment to round off the evening.

The highlight of the year is the Horticultural Show held at the beginning of September. It used to be held in a local field but the weather being so unpredictable it is now safely under cover in the Village Hall.

There was once a great deal of competition for the cups and shields, but sadly as the years have gone by a lot of the older gardeners have passed away.

New comers are very welcome to join the group or show their skills by entering the show. Non members are welcome to come on an ad hoc basis if any speakers' subjects are of interest – there is a £3 entry fee.

Membership subscription is £12 a year and reviewed at the AGM in March.

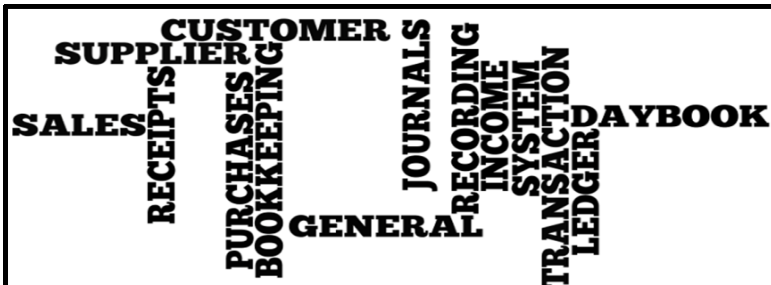

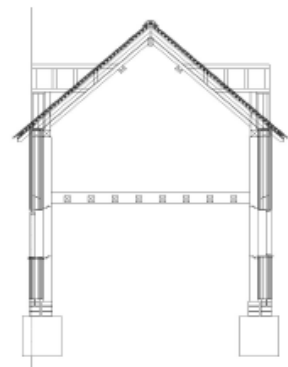

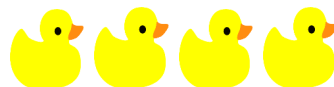
